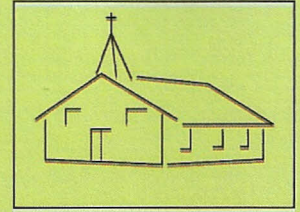
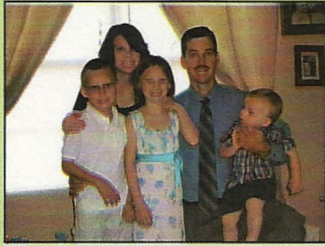

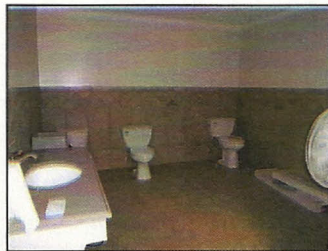
Thanks to all that continue to faithfully support the ministry. We are still asking people to pray with us about getting the debt on the travel trailer paid down. God Bless.

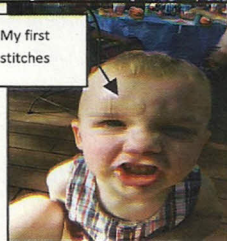
