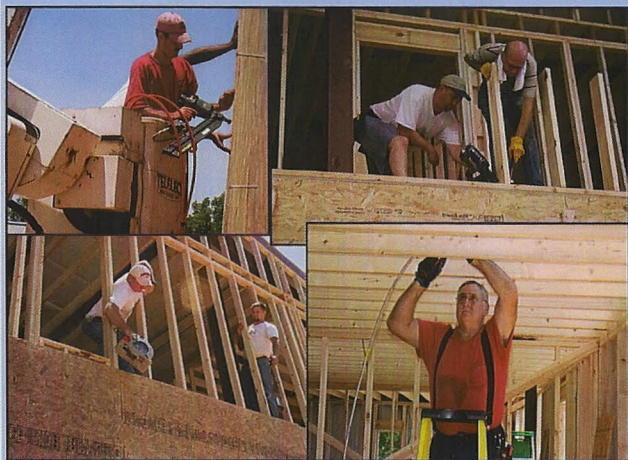


WHO WE ARE

Macedonian Building projects are made possible because of the dedication of a diverse group of construction trades personnel, as well as a host of people with no construction experience. All share a common burden to see the Kingdom of God advanced through the building of worship centers in foreign countries as well as the United States. This is an integral part of modern mission work.

How to be a part of the ministry... The Mission Builders are always praying for more men and women to help the ministry. With your help the Builders can continue to make a difference at home and abroad. We desire people who want to serve their Lord. That is the qualification of a Macedonian Builder.



WHAT WE OFFER

We will come and help you build your building, completing as much of it as possible during a one to two week project.



We will, through our mailing list of around 1,000 builders and the *Macedonian Call*, recruit other builders to volunteer their time and abilities to help you build.

We can help with technical support for the project and offer advice from our extensive experience in previous projects. We can help with material takeoffs, value engineering and site development.



We can often save a mission/church 30% to 40% by suggesting more cost effective construction materials.

We can offer the participants in the building projects an opportunity to do hands-on mission work and enjoy the fellowship of other believers in a common cause. We hear this so often from the participants, "I am a different person with a new vision for missions. I'm the one who got blessed."



How We Accept Invitations

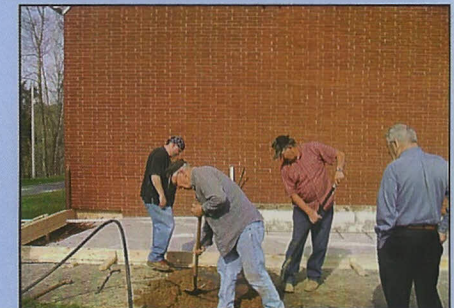
Invitations are accepted on a first come first serve basis following these priorities:

1st Priority—a Mission, foreign or domestic, needing a building for worship .

2nd Priority—a church, foreign or domestic, with no building.

3rd Priority—a church not financially able to hire a contractor to build for them.

4th Priority—an established church that would be enabled by help from the Builders to fulfill a greater commitment to missions.

Macedonian Builders encourage whole families, men, women, supervised youth groups and senior adults to participate in the building projects. There is something for everyone to do.

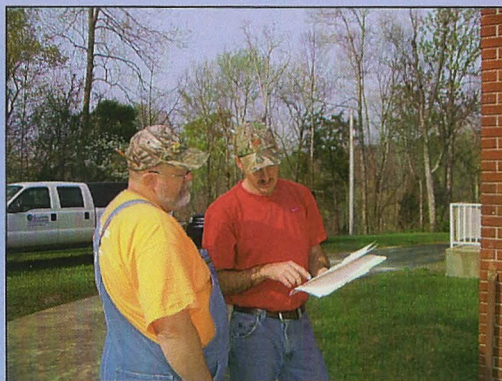


Building Project in Belize, 2010

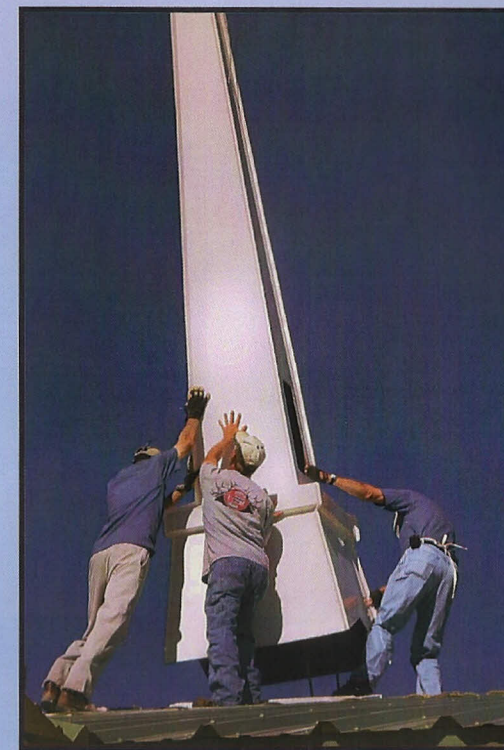
