The Mac-Med Team saw more than 1200 patients, filled 5,000-plus prescriptions, gave out over 200 pairs of reading glasses, passed out more than 150 Bibles and scores of gospel tracts, and witnessed 55 professions of faith.



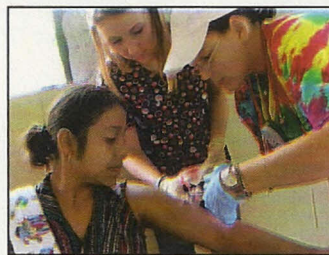

The mayor, the medical community, and all the people in the area, welcomed the group to Tonacatepeque. The main question they had was, "When are you coming back?"

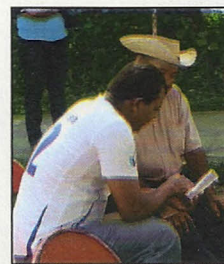
