Dear Co-Laborers,

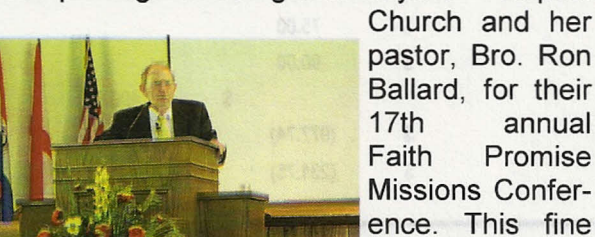
