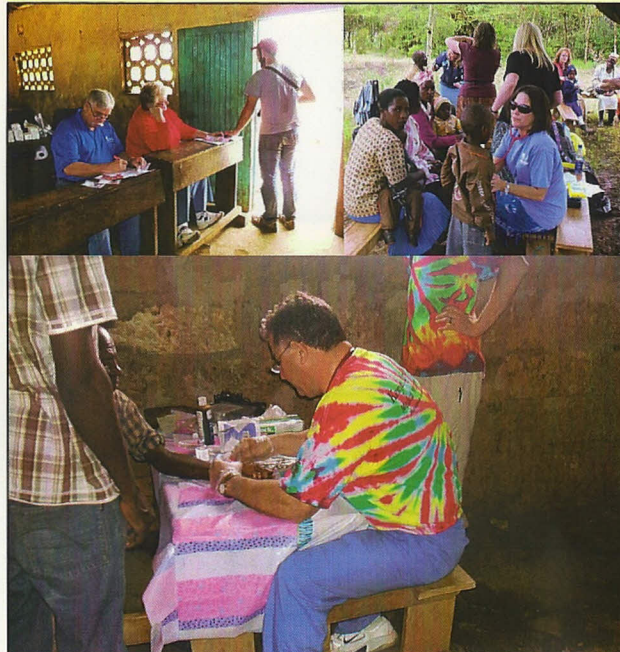
MacMed is committed
