I am excited to report that we saw sixty-seven professions of faith while we were there! One day we witnessed to a police officer who was sitting in his patrol car, and he accepted Christ as his savior. The very next day we talked to a lady who was walking on the sidewalk, and she also got saved. Afterward, she told us that she was the wife of the police officer from the day before!

We also had twenty-one volunteers from nine states working on the building project in San Luis Potosi. Some shoveled sand, some mixed concrete, some drove wheelbarrows, some filled buckets, and we all carried blocks! This building will give our brothers and sisters of San Luis Potosi a place to worship and grow, and be a blessing in that community.

To those who helped send us, and to those who were praying for us, I would like to remind you of the words Paul wrote in Philippians 4:17; that the work that was done in to San Luis Potosi is "fruit that may abound to your account," and I pray that work will continue to bear fruit for a long, long time.

As exciting as it was to be a part of the work there, and although it was bittersweet to say goodbye to Bro. Cande and everyone at the Iglesia, it sure was nice to get back to Kentucky and see my family waiting at the bottom of the escalators at the airport. We had never been apart for such an amount of time before. We got home the evening of Saturday the 12th, and I was asked to preach at Parkers Mill Road Baptist in Somerset on Sunday evening, the 13th. Parkers Mill Rd is a great church, and it was a pleasure to be with them. Bro. Darry Hatfield who pastors there took us to eat afterward, and has become a cherished friend since we moved here.

My parents, Obie and Cynda Jones surprised us with a visit from Texas for Thanksgiving. It was nice to be able to spend a few days with them and to show them around Somerset. One day we picked apples at Haney's Appledale Farms in Nancy, KY and Amanda made a fresh apple pie for Thanksgiving!

I would like to close by wishing you all a Merry Christmas. We are looking forward to spending a couple of weeks at home with our families, our church family, and Christmas dinner. Please continue to pray for our ministry, and know that we are praying with gladness and thanksgiving for all of you.
