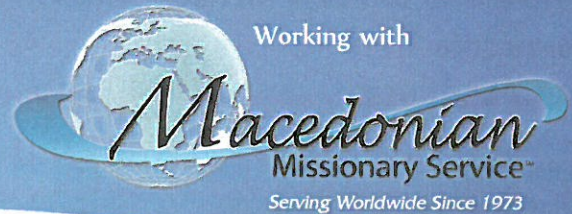




# Building Director Brant Lane

The revival meeting ended on Friday and early Saturday morning we headed to Wewoka, Oklahoma. Pastor Matt Wyatt and Mission Home MBC had invited me to meet with their men on Saturday evening and talk about their future building project. I enjoyed sharing with them and trying to answer some questions. On Sunday the church allowed me to preach and share the mission work.

My family raced back to Kentucky on Monday for me to put some final arrangements on the missionary home project that Macedonian was going to be starting on Monday, August 22. I appreciate all those who have had a part in this project so far. The trusses and floor system came out of Raney Components in Florida and were brought to Kentucky by Jeremy and Tonya Smith. We also had many volunteers getting the house framed up and into the dry. I want to thank White Oak Baptist Church youth who came out on Saturday the 27th and helped all day long on the project.

The mission home is located in Eubank, Kentucky which is about ten miles north of Somerset. The home sits on 11 acres. The house is a ranch on a basement and will have 1400 sq feet upstairs for a missionary to stay in and a studio apartment downstairs. There will be full hook ups for travel trailers and motorhomes. The project has an estimated cost of \$85,000. Macedonian has currently received about \$15,000, which leaves approximately \$70,000 more to get the home to completion. The house has a missionary and his family waiting on us to get it finished. Please consider this project.
