The month began with a building team in San Luis Potosi, Mexico. The builders had been asked to help Missionary Condi Esponsa and Faith Baptist Church. The church had purchased some property almost a year ago and had asked the builders to help them build a new sanctuary. The building team consisted of 21 team members from various states. The team was able to lay around 3500 blocks and poured a 26x48 second floor floating slab. This was a first for the building team. God was so good to the team. The fellowship, travel and weather were tremendous. The church people were amazing also, as many of them came each day to help with their project. When the team left, the first floor walls were up, the second floor concrete slab was poured, and the majority of the blocks for the second floor were layed in place. The welding team installed a beautiful set of stairs on the building to reach the second floor. God is so Good!!!!

This trip had an added bonus. Mike Ryan had spoken with to me a few months back about being burdened about evangelism and how we could incorporate more into the projects. He prayed about it and organized a small evangelism team to accompany the building team. They gave out around 600 bibles and had over 60 professions of faith. Did I say God is Good!!!! The Lord blesses effort. It was amazing as we saw police officers, children, moms and dads come to know Jesus. Praise the Lord!!! I appreciate Mike Ryan's heart and desire to increase our effectiveness as a ministry. We must continue to do just what he did and that is look for ways to get the gospel into the hands of the lost.

I arrived home on Saturday long enough to wash a few clothes and then head out again. This time I was headed to Sugar Creek MBC in Ironton, Ohio to help them with a revival meeting. I appreciate this church and her pastor Mike Long. The meeting went well and my family enjoyed staying with Ron and Kim Dickess along with getting to visit with many other friends.

We returned home on the 18th and I dove into working on the mission home. The mission home progress is going well. I want to thank those who have given of time, talents and treasure to help with this project. The home is in drywall, the outside only needs a little concrete work and some landscaping to be finished. If you would like to come and help on some of the inside work please give me a call. We will be installing hardwoods, cabinets, tile and trim in the next few weeks.

Also remember that through the end of the year we have matching funds up to \$25000 for the mission home. Many have taken advantage of this and I can not thank them enough.

Randi- Kim and Kim have been working very hard to secure the furnishing for the mission home. They have done a great job and the home and studio apartment are going to look so nice. I asked them to break out the cost to furnish each room. I have had inquiry about churches, Sunday school classes, or individuals participating in the cost to furnish the rooms. Here are the rooms and the associated cost- Kitchen \$850, family room \$1900, bedroom 1 \$1200, bedroom 2 \$1000, master bedroom \$2200, 3 bathrooms \$1500, laundry room \$1300, Dining room \$850, studio apartment \$1200.
