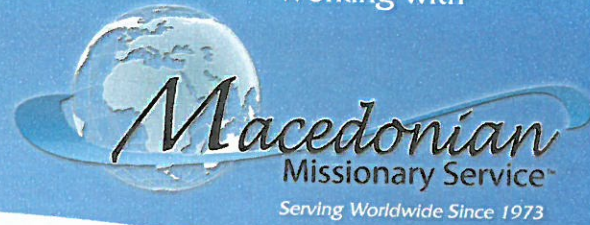

Dear Co-Laborers,

On July 4th we were able to celebrate with our family here in Kentucky; then on the 7th, Carole and I drove to Georgia. After spending the night there, we left for a medical mission trip to Romania. Mike Ryan and his wife, Erica, and granddaughter, Lily Fausti, joined Carole and me for our flight to Bucharest, Romania. Twenty-one of us, five of which were from Japan, all met Missionary Kevin Hutcheson and others for our near two week journey. We worked with pastors in the Brasof area for four days, working in different churches each day, and then returned to Bucharest and worked one and a half days with Bro. Kevin in Ocopen and Missionary Steve Rutherford the third day. Missionary Maniary also came and helped for two days. It was a good medical campaign, with several first time workers. The next campaign is planned for Cuba from October 20th thru the 28th.

Earlier I told you about the churches and Bible School in Cuba and the possibility of them getting a building to house their Bible School. They now have 69 students and definitely need more room. They can purchase a building for the reduced price of \$48,000.00. They have \$13,000.00 and need to raise \$35,000.00 more. This building would house the Bible School and some guest rooms could also be added for visiting preachers and teachers. They are asking for like faith preachers and teachers to come and help them.

For the duration of this medical campaign, they are obtaining religious visas for three of us: Dr. Raymond McAlister, (former president of Emmaus Bible College ), Dr. Hugo Mallozzi, and me. They have asked me to teach about stewardship while we are there.

Of the six that went on the initial survey trip in March, we all came to the same consensus; since we are of like faith, it would be better to help them get a meeting place and then have special speakers go down from time to time to help teach in their school. This would result in the strengthening of many indigenous churches and establishing of new ones.

If you would like to have a part in this project, you may send your offering to Macedonian Missionary Service, earmarked Cuban School Project. It would be great if purchases could be finalized before the team goes in October.

Thanks for caring and sharing. Thank you also for your prayerful support and contributions to my travel fund.
