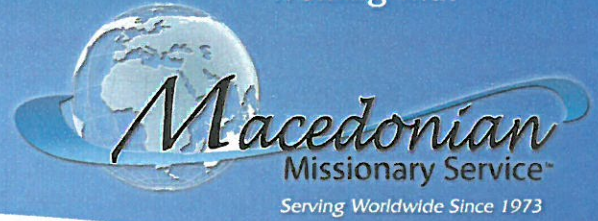

Dear Co-Laborers,

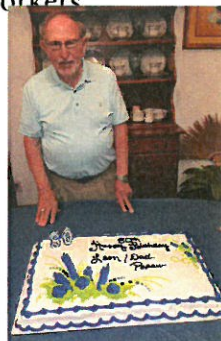
I love the month of August because it's my birth month. On August 6th, Carole, Kim and Randi-Kim surprised me with a great present. They threw me a celebration that included all my immediate family - cousins, nieces, nephews, and many more that came from Oklahoma, Florida, Mississippi, Alabama, Ohio and Georgia. The big 80, which was actually August 9th, was a great time of reunion.

Over the past couple months, I have shared with you about Cuba and the opportunity to help some of the churches there with their need to purchase property to expand their Bible teaching school. Praise the Lord, the finances for this project have been met! The Lord willing, we will be able to complete the transaction for the property while the MacMed Team is there in October. Please continue to pray that all goes well.

Once again the Lord has blessed, and we have been working on the Evening Shade Park. The park is eleven acres located near Somerset, Kentucky, in the township of Eubank, Kentucky. It was donated to Macedonian Missionary Service several years ago, with a suggestion that a place be built for pastors and missionaries to stay when they are in the area. When fully completed, the park will have RV hookups to accommodate those traveling in RVs. Macedonian had the land and 16,000 dollars to start with, but the Builders began building. Meanwhile, a businessman in Florida built the floor joists and roof trusses and a brother from Mississippi brought them to Kentucky as a donation. Other materials were purchased locally by faith. The first addition, a 1,300 square foot home, is now completely under roof.

The three bedroom home will serve as a place where the park caretaker will dwell. There is also a missionary guest suite located privately in the wal out basement of the home. Brandon Jones and his family will be the first to call "Evening Shade" home. Brandon and his wife, Amanda, and their two children will be living there while they raise support for Brandon's ministry. We are excited to be working with Brandon and his family. The balance needed to complete the project is approximately 65,000 dollars, plus the cost of furnishings for the missionary suite. Thank you to all who have come and helped work on the building, and to those who have donated materials and funds, and to those who provided lunch for the workers
