We had great participation from the local church as well as other churches in Mexico. One of the biggest blessings was that this trip we had a dedicated evangelism team to help get The Word out to the community. I'm humbled to report that God worked in the lives of many people and we had at least 65 professions of faith!!! What an awesome privilege to be a part of this work. Also while in Mexico I was able to preach for the first time through an interpreter. It's harder than I thought...

After returning home on Saturday night the 12th, I attended church Sunday morning at home and drove the short 7 hours to Jacksonville, Florida to help with the installation of a new metal roof. Satan tried to stop us in several different ways but Fouraker Baptist Church got the roof they needed. I want to thank the two men from Arkansas and the one from California who showed up to help me and one man from Florida. God knew just who we needed and He sent them with a heart to rise up and work. The church was given a quote for the work that said it would take two weeks...it was done in three days. Praise God for his Blessings.

After Jacksonville I was home for one full day then off again but this time Greta came with me and we went to see family in the beautiful mountains of West Virginia. We both have roots there and Thanksgiving just wouldn't be the same without family and deer hunting. Please pray for our families because like many of you, we have some in need of salvation. I think family is the most difficult to witness to.

The project in Grand Bay Alabama will be a lot of fun. When you read this, the project will be well underway or possibly completed. I hope to see you at The Baptist Chapel with Pastor Steve Merrit and that great of believers.
