Leigh and I first met when we worked closely together at the build in Bogalusa, Louisiana, and some of the people at EMBC mistook him for my dad! We aren't related (that I know of), but the Nichols have certainly become "like family" to us, and we enjoyed their hospitality.

After spending a night at Hillcrest MBC in Acworth, GA on Tuesday, we made it back to Somerset, KY on Wednesday, and were excited to see that the Evening Shade Park Mission Home was complete and ready for us to move in. We are grateful for everyone who had a hand in building the home, as well as for the ladies in the office who headed up furnishing and decorating the interior. The home provides a place for us, and missionaries like us, to stay while on deputation or furlough.
