I meet Pastor David Price at the church to bring the van back to the shop in Acworth, Georgia. The church had already fueled up the van, installed a new battery, and it didn't take me long to be back on the road to Georgia. What a blessing this is, the van will have some repairs completed, then turned over to a mission work.

Brother Terry Molden (Kentucky shop) has been making repairs to a van for delivery to Brother Chuck Fernandez at a mission work in Florida in the near future. Also, Brother Larry Frye has informed us of a need for a van for mission Pastor Craig Stark, Light of Grace Baptist Mission in Las Vegas, Nevada where he ministers to many in the homeless community in the area.

In order for us to be able to facilitate these repairs needed along with delivering to each mission point, we need some churches to sponsor these projects. Helping us raise the funds needed to repair the vans and go along side with us on the deliveries is a great mission project to be a part of.

We are constantly doing our best to upgrade our equipment at the shops that allow us to repair more vehicles for missionaries and churches; we are thankful for those who give to these needs. We have recently had the opportunity to purchase a Ford factory computer system from Ford at dealer cost-about \$ 1,500.00 for software, cable, license and program fees this will allow us the same capabilities as a Ford dealer with programming, etc. This is about 1/3 of retail cost, and we have stepped out in faith to secure this much needed piece of equipment. Any offerings to help with this cost would be a blessing and much appreciated.
