The month of March began on a Wednesday, and I had the privilege of preaching the first service of the month at Langdon Street Baptist Church in Somerset, Kentucky. Bro. Jerry Chandler, pastor at LSBC, had traveled to Arkansas to visit his brother, Lewis, who is battling cancer. I would like to ask that you all please remember Lewis in your prayers as he undergoes treatments. Bro. Jerry has become a dear friend, and LSBC has been the church we have attended when we are not traveling.

The following Sunday night I was blessed with another opportunity to preach; this time at White Oak Baptist Church in Nancy, Kentucky. White Oak, founded in 1801, is the oldest church in the ABA. I joked that preaching at White Oak felt a little like singing at the Grand Ole Opry. Can you imagine the history? One thing is for sure; they may be the oldest church in the ABA, but they are not living in the past. God is doing wonderful and exciting things at White Oak, and I appreciate the opportunity to take part in the services there every chance I get.

Please be in prayer for upcoming services where I will be presenting the works of Macedonian Missionary Service, and preaching God's Word, at a few of our churches in South Carolina. We will be traveling there the last Sunday in April, and the first Wednesday in May. I am also looking forward to being with some of our churches in Georgia and Florida in June around the time that we travel to Daytona Beach for the ABA National Meeting as well. Currently, these are the only engagements that we have on our schedule, so if your church would be interested in hearing from us, we would certainly love the invitation and the opportunity to worship together with you. It's the greatest thing in the world to be able to travel 800 miles from home, walk into one of our ABA churches, and feel like we're at a family reunion. We love meeting new family members wherever the Lord sends us!

The MacTech ministry has begun to take off, and we are excited about that. I spent the last week getting the "backend" configurations made on the server that will host the websites, and walking through the steps to load up new sites. We currently have a few sites that we have either already started working on, or will be starting on soon, including sites for Mackrill Romanian Missions (Kolt Mackrill), Teachers without Borders (Kabsu Kim), Davenport Music Ministries (William Davenport), and IMPACT Summer Mission Experience. (IMPACT stands for "I Must Personally Advance Christ Today.")

We are also working on a new radio broadcast we are calling "Missions Around the ABA" that will air on Enlightened Walk Radio, which you can listen to at enlightenedwalkradio.com, or through an app on your smartphone. We now have a pre-recorded intro and closing for the program, and I am beginning to conduct interviews of the missionaries that we will be featuring on the program. I would like to close with some personal prayer requests. Since moving from Texas to Kentucky, Caleb has battled sickness after sickness. This week we took him to the local asthma and allergy clinic for testing, and out of forty-six allergens applied to his back, he reacted to all but six. Those six were then retested on his arm, and he reacted to two more. He is allergic to cats, dogs, dust, and mold, all trees (except pine), all grasses and weeds. His worst reaction was to bluegrass, and we now live in the Bluegrass State! Caleb will begin allergy shots in a couple of weeks; two injections, three times weekly. Please pray with us concerning his health. Also, please pray with us about monthly support. We are currently supported by our sponsoring church, White Rock MBC, as well as Providence MBC, both in Center, Texas. That said, the Lord has faithfully provided, and we are grateful for His blessings and for those He uses!
