Dear Co-Laborers,

Our March weather has been quite boisterous! So has Macedonian Missionary Service. Good things have happened and are continuing to happen. While many members of the Macedonian Staff Team had the opportunity to go to the Holy Land, we have been busy here in the office. I am sure their trip was a real blessing and a great educational experience.

One of the exciting things happening at Macedonian is with the Radio Broadcast Ministry! Dr. Hugo Mallozzi is working with the broadcast, preaching in Spanish, over the Trans World Radio, 450,000 watt transmitter, from the island of Bonaire. The TWR transmitter is nine times stronger than any here in the United States, and reaches all of the Caribbean, Venezuela, Cuba, Colombia, Brazil, Mexico and many other countries. The Macedonian Radio Ministry now has an audience of 100 million Spanish-speaking people.

In a recent email, Bro. Hugo shared with me that they are asking for Bibles and Correspondence Bible Course booklets. This gives a greater opportunity to lead the listeners from doubt, to decision, to discipleship. You or your church can have a part in this great outreach ministry by first praying for the air time, which costs \$100.00 per program, and secondly, help us with air time funding, and Basic Bible Course and Correspondence booklets and Bible funding. The Bibles are \$4.00 each and the Correspondence Courses are \$1.00 each. I am excited about the radio ministry. Please be in prayer with us as God leads the way.

The Mechanics Ministry is flourishing. Over Easter weekend I had the privilege of meeting Bro. Jonathan Morgan, future missionary to Romania. He, his wife, Jennifer, and their three children will soon begin their deputation work in preparation for their move to Romania, where they will serve as full time missionaries. Bro. Jonathan came to Kentucky to receive a car that was donated to be given to a missionary in need. The Morgans had been praying for a vehicle to do their deputation work in while they are in the States. Upon the generous gift from a special donor, they received a car! Bro. Terry Molden, Missions Mechanic, looked the vehicle over and reported that it was indeed in excellent shape and needed very little tune-up.
