Thank God for the volunteers who make it possible.

After our trip to Mexico I was home just two days and flew to Israel. After our trip to Israel we started our spring revival at my home church, Hillcrest Baptist in Acworth, Ga. My Pastor Mike Maxwell had a great idea for our revival, and that was for the preachers within our church to each preach one night. My night was March 13, which happens to be my birthday. It was one of the best gifts I could possibly receive. Our revival was a great success by all accounts. I know I enjoyed it. The following weekend I attended the Georgia state meeting with several other from Hillcrest. It was a good meeting and great fellowship. Then I was off to Two Grey Hills Baptist Mission in the Navajo Nation in northwest New Mexico. Pastor Rusty Denny has been a great host each time I have been here. This trip we are installing all the plumbing, heating and air, and electrical rough-ins before sheetrock can be installed.

I had the awesome privilege to preach Easter Sunday evening message. I plan to be here for a week or ten days then back home to get ready for the Macedonian Banquet in Somerset, Kentucky. I hope to see all of you there on Friday evening, April 20th. It is always a good time. After the banquet, Greta and I will visit family in West Virginia for the weekend.

Our building project in Bloomington, Indiana is quickly approaching. We plan to build a new worship building for Pastor Scott Bourland and the fine folks at Journey Baptist Church. We will need all the help we can get to construct a new 41' x 117' wood frame building. Our goal is to begin work on May 12 and have the building up with the roof, siding, doors, and windows before we leave on May 26. We need your help. If you can't come and help physically, please pray for us as we labor for safety and discernment. Your spiritual help is vital to Gods Work. It's only with Him, by Him, and through Him that we are able to complete the task at hand. Pray for us as we continue to plan and coordinate all the details of this large undertaking. I look forward to seeing you there.
