We had shingled about a third of the roof and Frank and Derek quickly completed the shingles like only professional roofers could have done. Our Lord has been at work in those young mens lives. God has Blessed us and them through their willing hearts and His presence in all of our lives...Im overwhelmed. Thank You God!
