I was able to attend a mission rally in Stonewall, LA in January. The service was well attended and missionary, Trey Emory (Faith Mission in Sterlington, LA) brought a wonderful message. I just completed an Internet extension for a church. The church had an Internet connection in the main building, but not in the disjointed building where Sunday school classes and youth meet. The Internet Service Provider would have had them setup a second connection, doubling their monthly expense. I ran a new Cat5e cable through the attic to the outside of the building, installed a Ubiquity Rocket on the side of the building, and did the same thing in the disjointed building. With the two Ubiquity devices facing one another and clear line of site, the Internet connection can be extended for miles. Once the connection was extended, a SmartTV was mounted in the Teen Room and they are now streaming content to enhance their services. With the TV mount, we added an electrical outlet next to the TV on the wall, as well as an HDMI port on the wall for easy connectivity of wired devices. Very clean and useful.

Several websites are in the works. Some are pending content from the churches, and one is in limbo because of a prior domain registration issue that we are trying to work through. I did complete a couple of sites and have seven more on my schedule. A couple of other churches have expressed interest in having a site built but have not yet formally requested. Please continue to pray for the ministry.
