What an exceptional opportunity! I hope to return soon to see the results of their hard work.

We have been working hard to finalize our schedule for 2019. I think we know where we will be...however we are still ironing out the details of when it will be. We are working closely with Pastor Brian Caldwell and the fine folks at Providence Landmark Missionary Baptist Church in Fordyce, Arkansas. The church bought some property with the plans to build several years ago. Then last September the church building was destroyed by fire and the church's plans to build became a necessity. We have been assisting with drawings and planning and we tentatively hope to begin construction in the spring and the Macedonian Builders arriving JULY 6 for two weeks to do the interior framing. This is going to be a large interior framing job with two big buildings two stories each. Please plan to be there. We need YOUR help. I know our God will bless our efforts to further his work. Stay tuned.

We are also working with Pastor Jose Leos in the village of Pancho Villa, near San Fernando, Mexico. We hope to assist Iglesia Bautista Elim with raising five thousand dollars for the roof of their new 30'x50' church building the people have built. Please pray how you can help.

We have also been working with churches in Romania, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Florida, Montana, Louisiana, and Kentucky Please be in prayer for each of these projects and I praise God for the work He has placed before us. It is a reminder that God word will never return void and will always accomplish that which He pleases. In addition, we try to schedule as many mission conferences, revivals, and speaking engagements as is feasible. What a blessing it is to be busy! That means the churches are busy and growing, and people's lives are being changed by the Gospel of Jesus Christ. AMEN!

Greta's last day of work was January 31. We are making the transition from our life in Georgia to our new home in Kentucky. This is a huge step of faith and Greta's retirement will mean our income will change dramatically. We will be learning to survive on about 30% of what we had. God is the best Mathematician.
