We are also grateful to Gant Lake for supplying lunches for the workers each day. Through the combined efforts of these churches, we were able to reach over 70 families, all of which were new contacts for Legacy, and the following Sunday morning Legacy had six first time visitors from the camp, and a record attendance. I also witnessed the spiritual growth of our own people throughout the week. I would encourage anyone reading this letter to make plans to participate in a mission trip somewhere. I promise you there is no better investment when it comes to *redeeming the time.*
