1. Praise- the Mexico building project that was cancelled due to violence in the area has been completed. The men of the area came together and put the roof on the building.
2. Praise- Delta Regional Unit- this is a prison in Arkansas of over 620 inmates has approved for Macedonian to help build a chapel on site.
3. Praise- Radio broadcast continues to help lead people to the Lord. Many have jumped in to help reduce the financial deficit. Please pray for the funding of the last few stations. \$183.00 a month helps us to preach to 833 million people.
4. Praise- Macedonian builders have received \$10,000 for the spray foam machine. We only need to raise \$30,000 more to purchase the machine. We will need it by February next year.
5. Prayer- the computers at our Kentucky office have to be upgraded and replaced. \$5200 is what is needed to get things updated and replaced.
