Kenya / Uganda

This was my 6th trip to Africa since 2012, 5 times to the Kenya / Uganda area and one to S. Sudan. This trip I traveled with Bro. Chuck Fernandez and Bro Russell Bailey. We left on 09/11, returning on 09/26/2019. During the trip the Lord blessed in tremendous ways.

The first Sunday we were in country, we were able to go Kockaron, Uganda for services. This is the first time I have been at this church and I was given the honor to bring the morning message. Services started at 10am and went non-stop till about 1:30pm.

A portion of the work during our stay was conducting various pastors/preachers seminars. Bro Chuck taught on church Doctrine, Bro. Russell taught on Spiritual Warfare and I had the privilege to teach on Marriage/Family. Our first seminar was at Chepsoebe Landmark Baptist Church, in the Rift Valley, with about 40 men in attendance. This was one day of teaching.

On Wednesday & Thursday of that week, we conducted a two day seminar at Ndivsi Landmark Baptist Church. The Wednesday session started at 9:30am and concluded around 7:00pm. Thursday started up at 7:45am and went till about 1:00pm, allowing the men an early exit to travel back home, during daylight hours.

Much of the remainder of the trip was conducting village evangelism and working with the local pastors. Saturday we traveled to two villages where Pastor Shadrack has been trying to establish a new work, the villages of Evaklet & Sikulu. In doing local outreach we were blessed to lead 10 people to the saving knowledge of Christ. The local pastor can now flow up on these leads. Sunday we attended two of the local area churches, Mayanja Landmark Baptist Church & Chenjeni Landmark Baptist Church. I taught at Mayanja and preached at Chenjeni.

The Tuesday before we left we visited the church at Soy Sambu; Soy Sambu Landmark Baptist Church. We did village outreach, leading 6 to the Lord. After outreach we all met back at the church and the church asked that Russell and I pray for the individual children and families. After a time of prayer, the church conducted a baptism service. 9 people were to be baptized. We marched down to the river, about a mile away, and Bro Chuck, Bro Russel, and I were given the honor, and authority by the church to baptize the candidates. What a blessing.

As this was still the raining season, the weather was very pleasant, and even cool at times. Because of travel distance, we ended up sleeping out in 2 local villages for 3 nights, something I had never done before. It is something I hope I never forget, camping in the Rift Valley of Africa. Please continue to pray for the Brothers and Sisters in Kenya/Uganda. That the Lord would allow the work there to continue to grow as it has over the years.
