Wind Storms

The last week of October here in California saw damaging wind storms with gusts in our area of close to 100 mph. These winds are what fuel the local area fires. Because of this, Pacific Gas & Electric has gone to shut-ting down large sections of power lines to try and help prevent fires from downed power lines that are live. On the surface this appears to be a good thing, but the problem is it cuts power to many homes and businesses. Apparently we live in a fire hazard area. We lost power at our house for 4 consecutive days. We were some-what prepared with extra ice and had moved all our food into the freezer, but after 4 days we lost all of our re-frigerated foods. We did have plenty of batteries and flashlights and lanterns. We also lost power to our office. Because of that I did ended up buying a portable generator in order to get our computers up and running and restore some power back to the house. Being creatures of habit, even after 4 days of no power, each time we walked into a room we instinctively turned on the light switch. Have never been without power for that length of time, it's different and we don't recommend it to anyone. But God provided.

November 15th - 23rd a team is headed into Peru for a medical campaign.
