Many made the difficult decision to cease meeting together for regular services in order to comply with government recommendations and to prevent the spread of the disease. This left many asking questions like, "How do we stream our services online for our people," and "How do we receive tithes and offerings online?"

While much of the rest of the world came to a screeching halt, the MacTech ministry was full steam ahead. Pastors and missionaries from all around the country were calling at all hours of the day and night, seeking answers to these questions. I worked around the clock to make sure every church that asked for my help was up and running by the next Sunday morning. The team at Anedot, the online fund raising platform that I use, also worked late into the evening on Saturdays to make sure churches were ready to accept tithes and offerings online or by text. Could God's call on my life to begin this ministry in 2016 have been His providential hand preparing someone for such a time as this?

Prior to the coronavirus outbreak, I did have the opportunity to travel to Texas with the MacTech ministry. I shared the Macedonian work at Eastside Baptist in Gary, Texas on a Wednesday evening, gave a report at White Rock MBC in Center, Texas on the following Sunday morning, and shared the Macedonian ministry at Eastside Baptist in Minden, Louisiana that night. Eastside in Minden voted that night to have me design a logo, build a website and setup online giving for their church.
