It is hard to believe that we have already reached the midpoint of this year. They say "Hindsight is 20/20" but with all of the chaos this year has brought, I think we will all be glad when 2020 is in our hindights.

Still, the MacTech ministry has been extremely busy. We are taking as much precaution as we can, but the work must go on. I have visited the seminary in Minden twice recently for technology installations, and visited Central MBC in Bastrop, LA for a consultation on new A/V equipment. Equipment has been ordered and will be installed when it comes in. A/V equipment is still on backorder, but we are beginning to see some items ship out. I still have backordered items for several churches, so things will get even more busy when those orders are filled.

I also consulted via Facetime with Promise Land MBC in Hamburg, AR. I will be completing another large installation there when equipment arrives, just like the one I have planned in El Dorado, AR as well. These churches both went with the PTZ (pan tilt zoom) cameras that can be remotely controlled.

I am also working on a website rebuild for Camp Glenwood, a church camp in Folsom, LA, sponsored by Emmanuel MBC in Bogalusa, LA. The current site is hosted with Wix, and renews in July. Before the renewal date, I should have the new site built on my server, where it will be hosted for free. Ray Meigs, the manager at Camp Glenwood, will then be able to cancel his Wix service and save the camp some money.

In the month of June, I spoke with two young men who both expressed an interest in participating with the MacTech ministry. One from Oklahoma and one from Texas. Both are well qualified men with education and experience in technology. Please pray for these men as they seek the Lord's will for them and how they might serve Him.

I will be in Norman, Oklahoma near the end of July to install new equipment ordered for Concord Baptist Institute. This equipment, including a 75" tv on a rolling cart, a Logitech Group conferencing system, and an Apple Mac Mini computer, will allow the seminary to stream and record classes with a very professional setup. I request your prayers as I complete these major projects.
